

RANKIN BROTHERS & SONS TROPHY 2023

This year's Trophy was contested by 41 participants – a great turn-out. After last year's washout at Lisbon Sports Club, and heavy October rains all participants were happy to play on a dry day. The soggy course made for challenging conditions but there was much at stake – not only the Rankin Brothers & Sons Trophy but also the Silver Jubilee Plate. At the start of play there were a dozen participants separated by less than 7 points and vying for the Silver Plate.

The overall quality of play was quite good with approx. half the participants scoring 30+ points. The pin positions were testing which meant that birdies were hard to come by, yet there were 14 in total with Michael Deignan scoring two!



Results: Nearest the Pin:

Hole #2: Gentlemen: This green is readily accessible to most of the field but the flag position on the right-side front made it a big challenge – and the hole gave up only one birdie on the day. Nearest the Pin – Yellow tees– DAVID WRIGHT

This is challenging hole on most days – but with the pin position on the back left it is devilishly difficult and there were no birdies on the day.
